2 Scope

- (1) This policy applies to all training and assessment activities taking place within the sphere of operations of the Jan Juc Surf Lifesaving Club Inc (**Club**).

3 Policy Statement

- (2) It is the policy of the Club to provide a safe environment for the conduct of training and assessment activities, specifically activities taking place in an aquatic environment.

4 Implementation Procedure

- (3) All training and assessment activities at the Club should be supervised by persons holding a valid LSV Bronze Medallion (**Water Safety Officers**). The ratio of Water Safety Officers to candidates should be not less than 1 Water Safety Officer to 10 candidates.
- (4) In addition to the above whenever candidates are in the water a fully operational IRB should be in the water crewed by qualified persons and positioned, with regard to the prevailing conditions, such that a clear view of all candidates may be maintained at all times.
- (5) For the avoidance of doubt training and assessment activities does not include senior or junior surf-sport training sessions.

- (6) For the further avoidance of doubt training and assessment activities does not include scheduled 'Nipper' activities which are the subject of LSV policy 1.1:Pol:1 *Junior Activities and Water Safety*.
