

It is a great honour to present to members a report on the 2021/2022 season and outline enhancements and further developments of the clubs strategic objectives.

New initiatives have been implemented across all areas of the club this year.

- Patrol: new roster and core patrol system to assist with team building in core patrol groups, and ensure a spread of skills & experience across all patrols.
- Training: Offered training in all available lifesaving awards that can be offered at club level, with several offered in multiple formats to meet the needs of groups of members. Progressed plans to increase cohort of trainers & assessors across all awards at the club.
- Competition: Enhanced training schedule to maximise participation. Record participation in competition at state and Australian titles levels. Athletes involved in

State high performance squads. Head Coach (Tim Watson) - Surfside Dolphins - Surf Sports Development Nipper Regional Teams Challenge, and Tim has also joined the LSV Development Panel. Continued rebuild of our surfboats section, with 4 new crews competing.

- Community: MoU with other community organisations such as Torquay Boardriders to promote common areas of interest around safe use of the beach. Endorsement of Statement of Reconciliation and commencing engagement with local traditional owners to develop a Reconciliation Action Plan.
- LSV: partnered with statewide services (particularly RWC) to host this service, and participate in evolution of the service. Hosted early season senior carnival. Hosted state

titles for several of the lifesaving disciplines. Hosted western region VVE event.

• Mental health: Jan Juc operated a specific mental health awareness patrol early in the season. This was followed by a members/ public event to increase awareness of mental health issues featuring guest speaker: The National CEO of Headspace (National youth mental health initiative). Given the effects on all of the COVID pandemic, this was very well received by those who attended.

Development of members' engagement with club programs

The next phase of development of our community connectedness will include:

· The development of a Reconciliation

Action Plan, following our recent decision to adopt a statement of reconciliation and commencement of engagement with local traditional owners.

• Progression of activities covered under our MoU with Torquay Boardriders Club, including events around the Rip Curl Pro surfing event, local competitions and planning for further shared training and education opportunities for the juniors involved in both clubs.

Implementation of improvement measures across areas of governance and leadership

Like many clubs coming out of the COVID period, Jan Juc had record membership, nippers participation and overall member engagement.

Governance: Our Audit, Finance & Governance committee continues to provide advice to the board. Changes currently being considered around governance to balance stability and succession of key roles around the club. Ongoing program of strategic review continues in response to changes in the external environment. Succession planning in place for approx 80% of key roles on the board and around the club.

Leadership: our club was represented (usually by multiple participants) in every available leadership development opportunity offered through LSV.

Delivery of lifesaving services

During the 2021/12 Season, 169 volunteer surf lifesavers provided support and assistance through beach safety patrols for residents and tourists. Our lifesavers provided 2,777.41 volunteer hours to ensure that those visiting our beaches were safe to enjoy the aquatic environments. During this time they saved the lives of 10 people, provided 4,168 preventative actions and administered first aid to 337 people.

Development of member's skills base

In the 2021/22 season Jan Juc offered training in every award available to be offered at club level in multiple formats. In addition to this, a new approach to introducing young members to lifesaving competition events was trialled. Jan Juc members continue to participate in the broader lifesaving community with many new Gold Medallion recipients, RWC operators and ongoing participation of members in the Westpac helicopter service.

Club involvement within LSV programs/ initiatives e.g. sport, nippers, training & assessment

Jan Juc has a strong history involvement in many LSV programs and initiatives. In

addition to the usual levels of engagement in sport, nippers and Training/assessment in 2021/22 Jan Juc SLSC did the following:

- · Host early season senior carnival
- Host State titles for several lifesaving events (champion lifesaver and patrol competition)
- Host western region valuing volunteers event
- Host RWCs as part of the statewide service, operation site for statewide call out service.
- Participation of our members in every available leadership development camp.
- Pink patrol and IWD events were a great success.

Community engagement or community support initiatives

Our desire to make a difference in our local community is reflected through:

- In 2021/22 Jan Juc offered the starfish nippers program for the first time. This complements our ongoing focus on access for people with disability such as
- A modified nippers program offered for Kids+ to provide a further aquatic experience for young people with a disability
- Scheduled sessions promoted through the broader community and disability support groups to utilise our matting a specialised wheelchairs to facilitate water access for all at both Jan Juc beach and at Fisherman's beach in Torquay.
- Regular donations of t-shirts to other Community Service groups (e.g. Geelong Mums and Geelong-Viqueque Friendship Schools);
- Providing a modified Nipper program for the Kids Plus Foundation;
- · Using and promoting local businesses.

The Club's environmental sustainability initiatives focus on limiting pollution through:

- Reuse (e.g. purchasing a used SBSV rather than seek funding for a new vehicle);
- Recycling;
- Running plastic free events;
- Facilitating green commuting for employees & volunteers.

The Future

The current board is in the process of completing the development of a strategic planning framework to guide the development of the club over the coming years. This framework will be centres on the club continuing to be an exemplar lifesaving club. It will focus future effort on continuing to provide a connected, healthy, purposeful community for our members to ensure everyone has a chance to safely enjoy the beautiful environment we are in.

I'd like to thank the hundreds of volunteers who make our club what it is today. In particular, the current Board of Directors and other leaders who spend countless hours making the club a better place. It has been a great honour to serve as president in the 2021-2022 season.

VICE PRESIDENT REPORT



The 2021/22 lifesaving season presented some challenges from a club core business perspective, patrolling the beach & training our members – these programs at the start of the season were navigating the unknown, was the season going to be a replication of the previous year with rolling lockdowns or were we going to be permanently open for business.

As always, the Juc team rose to this challenge with each of the Board departments displaying resilience in the uncertain time.

My first task was to recruit a President & Lifesaving Skills & Development Manager, ironically both these positions were filled from the same family, Marcus & Finn Dripps.

As the Vice President, a specific portfolio of responsibilities is not allocated, which allows for special projects to be undertaken. Projects that if added to Board members who have specific responsibilities could prove a challenge to execute with the extra workload.

An example of this was mid-season, both beach vehicles were out of service, one permanently, Lifesaving Service manager requested assistance on a Monday to provide a solution – by the weekend I had secured a new vehicle ensuring patrols were not left short.

Per previous years a large portion of my VP time is dedicated to the facility, continuing to fit out the club facility as funds have become available.

During the past 12 months we have:

- Installed an AV system including speakers & display screens
- · A screen to the kitchen servery
- New chairs & tables for functions & training spaces
- New storage cages for the downstairs storage space
- New IRB dry storage
- Fitting out the facility with various historical memorabilia & preparing to install new honour boards.
- Commenced maintenance schedules

I am assisted in the facilities maintenance by John Van Ooi, Geoff Ras Thompstone, Peter Saw & Brett Thompson. We have held more functions over the past 12 months than previously, and the inbound enquiries continue to grow. I welcome Leesa Downes who has proactively taken on the functions manager role, and together we will continue to work towards function packages to simplify the responses.

Among the functions approximately 50% have been the local community utilizing the space for various activities, presentations, birthdays, corporate events and even card nights.

As per the previous year the bar operations on a Friday & Sunday which is providing a welcomed source of income. I am supported in the bar space by lots of members who volunteer their time to do a few hours and contribute to the bar operations. The five cellar masters Brett, Eugene, Andrew, Brendan & Stewart are fantastic and have ensured the bar opens and beer keeps flowing.

VICE-PRESIDENT REPORT CONTINUED

As the club continues to foster community relationships it was most rewarding to have young local families visit the bar on a Sunday afternoons with tunes playing and food trucks providing food and the children playing on the grass.

While drafting this report I contemplated my time at the Jan Juc Surf Lifesaving Club. 30th Jan 1982, I can only remember being proud of being part of a great and unique community organization. We have such a proud legacy of being progressive, not always first to market, but certainly early adopters. Here are a few, and not all from the aquatic knowledge they gain. past 12 months.

- · Donating all funds from an intersection collection to the bush fire appeal
- Donating equipment to clubs in need
- Creating strategic alliances with community organizations - most resent - Torquay Boardriders - to my knowledge the second surf club in Australia to achieve this, Torquay See you on the beach. Lions and Torquay Rotary among others.
- · Using Bronze and SRC children as Age **Group Managers**
- The Kids Plus Program
- · The Star Fish program
- · Introducing our Indigenous youth to the surf program

- · Implementing a youth training facility
- · Having the foresight to commence the facility redevelopment project and create a community space - it has been very rewarding to see so many local families with young children sharing our space on a Sunday afternoon.

In summary, as the club nears 1500 members we should pause and take account of the position we are currently in.

Zero debt, a 6.7mill facility, 2 x ATV beach vehicles, new rescue boards etc. an amazing competition and junior season it is testimony to the amazing work of our dedicated members.



SECRETARY REPORT



Well, the Clubhouse facility is up and fully functional, Club life is back to normal, well almost, as we all learn to cope with the "Virus" in our lives. Coming out of the restrictive COVID years, much was achieved last season, with outstanding contributions by Members in all areas of our operations, building the base for forthcoming years.

Firstly, under the guidance of our Financial Maestro – Finance Manager Melissa Field, the debt on the building Bank Loan has been reduced to under \$200,000 – outstanding for a new building that cost in excess of \$6.5 million. Whilst the past two years have been fiscally tight, as a result of careful financial management and planning the Club has still been able to continue to provide new equipment for patrols (i.e. with grant assistance two new Polaris ATVs), competition, building contents, capital expenditure, various subsidies for training and learning opportunities.

Events wise, the Bells Bash Cliff Run and Danger Ocean Swim Series, were held later than normal in the year which had an obvious effect on entries and as a result incurred a loss. However, at least the events remain on the calendar for next year and back in the

normal time zone, which, with appropriate thoughtful and intuitive promotion will bring back the interest and subsequent numbers to the events. With some new innovative additions to the Golf Classic, thanks to organiser Jeremy Bond, this successful event culminated with meals and presentations back at the Club.

Membership climbed to just under 1,500 – locals starting to adopt the Club as their own, with increased patronage, together with continued Nipper membership growth.

Patrol wise, whilst the Club continued to successfully provide patrol coverage and associated water safety and first aid to the beachgoers over a long season, as a long time patroller, it was disappointing to note that on some occasions Patrol numbers were down to the minimum four or five attendees.

No doubt an off season review of Patrols in general, will consider ways and means of highlighting and implementing the focus on the Club's core business of Lifesaving.

Congratulations to Jaci Chin-Jewson on being elected to Life Member status. Following completion of the nomination process, approval of the nomination was granted by Members in attendance at the Annual General Meeting held on the 29/8/2021.

Jaci joined the Club in December 1989, obtaining her Bronze Medallion at that time and completed 15 years of patrolling service up to 2016/17 season.

A 30 year involvement with the Club, includes Committee positions of Publications Manager, Communications & Publications Manager, Membership Manager, together with several years of administration duties supporting the Life Saving Skills Development area, Kids Plus Program and more recently the Starfish Program.

In the publications arena, Jaci was responsible for all outgoing communications including publication of Annual Reports - LSV on several occasions acknowledged the excellence of the reports on the basis of structure, content and presentation.

PATROL OPERATIONS REPORT



In November we had our first Men's Mental Health Patrol where we had a core patrol of male leaders who engaged with all patrol members to create a place of support to encourage people to share and have conversations and check in of support. Mr Pig brought out the Salad Rolls to feed the army and following patrol we gathered in the club to listen to Jason from Headspace who gave us some tools to support friends and colleagues in this space.

Juc was also one of over 30 clubs in the state to host a Pink Patrol in March in line with International Women's Day. Before patrol we hosted a morning tea where all female club members were welcome to attend, it was great to see nippers to life members mingling over sponge cake and watermelon! After morning tea we then all headed down to the beach for patrol which was led by a female core group.

This season we had seven Core Patrols Teams, which were made up of 38 core members. These core members are leaders from the club, have gained all awards necessary for their position and are experienced in patrol operations. The objective of the core group is to ensure our patrols are equipped with a strong group of leaders, to cover the compulsory awards and to upskill active members into core positions as well. We also had our Active Patrollers this

season, these members selected the days which worked best for them to patrol. It is hoped that our Core groups will continue to grow with more Active Member choosing to join the patrol teams.

Working alongside our beach Lifesavers, Jan Juc also hosted a Lifesaving Victoria, RWC site. This site was used by both Lifesavers and Lifeguards. The benefits of having extra operational capacity at Jan Juc was evident in the number of call outs this service completed and the support it is able to provide to our patrols and the community.

We are so incredibly proud of all our Lifesavers this season who managed thousands of people a day, the ever-present risk of COVID, strong rips and challenging surf conditions. A special thank you to all of our patrol captains and the Juc Operations Committee;



As always, our Juc FA gear passed inspection without question and I am grateful to all those members whom assisted in restocking and maintaining our gear for the season.



STEVE JEWSON STARLIGHT NIPPERS PROGRAM









After many discussions over the years since running Juc's Nipper Program with the Starfish Nippers Program creator, the late Janet Jones from Anglesea, we finally decided we had the time and were ready to run the program at Jan Juc.

The major concern for us was the beach conditions at Jan Juc, which can be challenging at times for mainstream Nippers. After leaving my board position at the end of last season and with four years of running the Kids Plus program under my belt, Jaci talked me into starting the program. Together we met with Janet who was supportive and encouraging and convinced us that between the two of us we could do it.

Jaci got to work setting up the administration side, collecting resources and sourcing grants to assist with setting up the program while I set about sourcing personnel to act as mentors. Together we met with each Starfish Nipper before the commencement of the program so that we could get to know them and make sure they had a familiar face for their first day on the beach. Janet had agreed to have a chat with our mentors to pass on her incredible experience and valuable tips,

but unfortunately, we lost her before we could get the gang together.

Although Starfish Nippers is designed to integrate our special needs kids into the mainstream Nipper Program, we found the beach conditions at Jan Juc to be too difficult much of the time and so opted to run most sessions at Cosy Corner. Some of these sessions did include the entire Nipper Program.

We had an outstanding group of 5 Starfish Nippers – Xavier, Flynn, Noah, Alison and Thomas (AKA 'Rudy'), each who brought their unique personality, resilience, courage and enthusiasm to the beach each day. It is a joy to be on the beach and watch beach and water skills develop in kids who have had little experience in an aquatic environment. I especially enjoyed the trust developing between Starfish Nippers and mentors. You

all achieved so much in your first year and should be extremely proud of yourselves, even if it was just mastering getting a wetsuit on!

We would like to thank our very special mentors – Georgia Richards, Jess Elliott, Patrick & Emer Oxspring, and Isela Frausto-Bridges who always put their Nippers first. Your support and commitment ensure that we can run the program and that every Nipper can be supported and extended throughout their season.

The perfect end to our season was the giant SUP from Go Ride a Wave (who provided the board and Matt Solly free of charge!). We managed to get all but one Starfish Nipper on the board and caught many waves. Xavier 'X-Man' jumped with joy, Flynn grew in confidence and Alison was doing summersaults off the board. Our biggest achievement was getting Noah on the board

– twice! The jury is still out on who had more fun – Starfish or mentors!

There is absolutely no way I could have achieved getting this program off the ground without Jaci in the background. Amazingly she kept me organised and even managed to attend two sessions despite holding down a very busy full time job. We are very excited and enthusiastic about growing our program next season.

On a similar note, Jaci and I are currently working with Life Saving Victoria, Torquay Angling Club and GORCAPA on beach accessibility so watch this space.



Our friends at the Brewery have been incredibly supportive creating a community beer benefiting the Jan Juc Surf Lifesaving Club with every purchase.


The local community has been supporting the beer in a huge way it it recently won a silver medal at the Silver at the Australian International Beer Awards.

FINANCE REPORT

I am pleased to report a very solid results year for Jan Juc Surf Life Saving Club in what has been hopefully our last seriously Covid impacted set of results.

The club's audited financial statements report an accounting profit before depreciation (a non cash item) for the 2022 year of \$170,397, and a loss after depreciation of \$52,793. This compares to a reported profit for 2021 of \$437,432, which included \$460,000 in capital grants for the building redevelopment.

Covid impact

The 2022 results were significantly impacted by Covid lockdowns again in late 2021. The Grand Final Eve fundraising event was cancelled and the Danger Swim Series and Bells Bash struggled with significantly lower participation following the postponement of the event from its usual early January time. The lost profits from these events were partially offset with \$48,435 in Covid grants and subsidies.

Ongoing operations

Despite impacts of Covid, our core activities including lifesaving operations (patrols), lifesaving skills development (SRC, Bronze and other training courses), junior and senior competition, nippers and surf education were all conducted at full strength over the season and apart from membership income, which exceeded budget, all areas operated financially within expectations.

The attractiveness of the Club's offerings was reflected in another year of significant membership growth, with membership revenues up 17% - on top of a 39% increase in 2021.

Through the generous support of our volunteers operating the club bar, bar operations and social events also contributed a net profit of \$34,445 to the club.

The efforts of our volunteer coordinators saw member support at the Golf Day contribute substantially to the Club's fundraising result.

Similarly, the extension of our water safety services to Iron Man Melbourne, in addition to Iron Man Geelong, and the support of our volunteers in delivering those services has also substantially assisted the club financially.

Maintaining our assets – continued investment

The club has been successful in accessing a variety of capital grants and sponsorships this year and this combined with some generous donations from club members has enabled us to continue to invest in operational equipment this year.

The club invested \$152,168 in assets during during the year, including for 1 x ATV, installation of 'dumb waiter', clubhouse tables and chairs, 7 rescue boards, 2 surf skis, 10 racing mals, 1 IRB powered engine lifter, 6 G-boards, Boat oars and rowlocks and 25 nipper boards. Additionally, at year end the club had deposits and/or backorders with suppliers for several assets including for a new ATV and for further clubhouse audio visual equipment.

Cashflow and financial position

Cashflow has been managed closely and with the finalisation of receipt of all grant funding associated with the building

redevelopment, we have been able to deposit \$200,000 against our bank borrowings in addition to normal annual repayments. These funds are available to be redrawn as required. As at yearend total bank borrowings outstanding was \$174,843 compared to \$399,584 at the end of 2021. In addition, as at vear end cash on hand balances totalled \$213,102 meaning the club, when offsetting borrowings with cash on hand, is essentially debt free. This is an outstanding financial position to be in the second year following completion of the building redevelopment and following the significant impacts of Covid on the last two years of operations.
